First Holy Communion 2024. The second session will take place this Sunday, 7th April at 10am. Easter Duties: It is a rule of our religion that all Catholics should go to confession at least once a year, and to Holy Communion at Easter or thereabouts. In England and Wales the period for making our "Easter Duties" extends from Ash Wednesday to Trinity Sunday. The number of penitents during Lent and Holy Week has been excellent, but in case you have not been to confession for some time, please do not neglect this important aspect of the Sacramental life of the Church.
