This Weekend we welcome Helen Brand who will be speaking at all Masses in the Parish of Our Lady & St Joseph's about the Embrace Project.

The Congregation for Worship in Rome has confirmed the request of the Bishops of England & Wales that the Feast of the Epiphany is restored to the 6th January and the Feast of the Ascension is also restored to the Thursday after the sixth Sunday of Easter and this takes effect from next year. Both these Feasts remain a Holy Day of Obligation.

St. Anne's School: the Ofsted inspectors visited school in June and their final report has just arrived this week and everyone is disappointed at both the findings of the inspection and the overall rating given to the school, especially as it comes so quickly after St. Anne's was judged to be a "Good Catholic School" by inspectors from the Diocese of Leeds. The Trust Board takes its responsibility towards St. Anne's very seriously and has therefore taken a number of swift and decisive actions to address the issues raised in the report.

- We have replaced the Academy Council with a Trust Intervention Board which is made up of a number of Trust Directors, the Diocesan deputy director of education and expert support from both the Catholic Schools Partnership and higher education in Bradford. This board will provide the governance for the school going forwards and will work with the trust Board to ensure that the school responds strongly to all the issues identified by Ofsted.
- We have worked extensively with the school and experts from the local authority to make sure that all safeguarding issues raised by the inspectors have been fully addressed. Providing a safe and secure environment for every child in our care remains our primary concern.
- We have asked Mrs Katy Cox, a very experienced Headteacher from Bradford and a former director of the Catholic Schools Partnership to provide a significant level of support to our school over the coming months. Mr Poulton is away from school at the moment for personal reasons, so we have asked Mrs Cox to provide support as the Interim Consultant Headteacher.
- Canon McCreddie will help the Trust Intervention Board by focusing on both the Catholic Life of the school and Religious education - which goes to the heart of who we are and, of course, as Parish Priest he will continue to provide pastoral care for everyone in the school community.

There is much work to be done to bring the school back to where we want it to be but let us not forget that St. Anne's is a good Catholic School, at the heart of our community. It is our school and we all have a part to play in supporting our school's journey back to a good Ofsted rating.
