The Bishop's new Programme for First Confession, First Holy Communion & Confirmation (SA)

St Anne's Restoration Fund:

The final work on the altars will be completed in February and we will have £12,000 left in the fund. In the last few months there have been problems with the church lighting and after a visit from the architect last week he has proposed that we go ahead with the LED relighting of the Church which will then conclude all the restoration work. The various applications will now be made to Historic Churches for permission and a definite price will be worked out but an estimate is in the region of £20,000. The work could begin in the summer and we still have the weekly bucket collection and some monthly donations direct to the restoration fund. Therefore by August 2018 we should have £15,000 in the restoration fund which means we will need to raise a further £5,000 to pay for the whole project. I hope we can complete this work next year as the new lighting system will transform all the beautiful restoration work.

Act in Support of Catholic Education

Do you support Catholic schools and the right of Catholics to send their children to them? Then we need you to make your voice heard. The Government is making a critical decision on whether to overturn the admissions cap which prevents new Catholic schools from allowing all Catholic pupils to attend. The Prime Minister has acknowledged that this policy discriminates against Catholics and had promised previously to abandon it. Now the Government may decide to keep this discriminatory policy in place instead of removing it. We need you to tell the Government not to discriminate against Catholics and to remove the admissions cap on new faith-based schools.
